## **Word Game of the Week!**

### **20 questions:**

To play this game you need 2+ players.

- One player must think of an object, person or animal.
- The other players take turns to ask yes/no questions.
- They have 20 questions to find out what the person is thinking.

### **Variation:**

Start with a smaller category e.g. animals, objects you find in a house. This gives the players guessing a clue and an easier start point.

### **What areas does this game help?**

Social skills:

A core social skill is taking equal turns in conversations. This game gives students a structured opportunity to practice and apply this skill.

Language:

Each player will use their knowledge of categories so help narrow down the answer. Learning about categories helps children to organise and expand their vocabulary knowledge. This helps their ability to comprehend, store and retrieve information.
